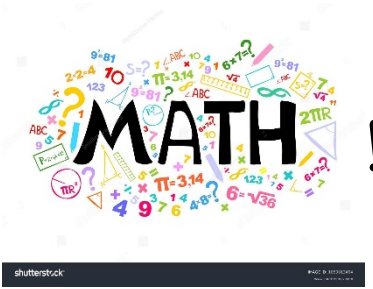


# Welcome to Middle School
